



May 3, 1917: Governor John F. A. Strong approved a bill that created the Alaska Agricultural College and School of Mines, today the University of Alaska Fairbanks. May 5, 1961: Alan Shepard became the first American in space.

<u>May 6, 1937</u>: The German airship Hindenburg burst into flames at 7:20 p.m. as it neared the mooring mast at Lakehurst, New Jersey, following a trans-Atlantic voyage. <u>May 10, 1957</u>: President Dwight Eisenhower nominated Mike Stepovich to be governor of territorial Alaska. Stepovich served as the last governor before Alaska became a state.

May 17, 1875: The first Kentucky Derby horse race took place at Churchill Downs in Louisville.

May 23, 1935: Officials held a drawing at the newly established Matanuska Colony to award the first 200 tracts to the settlers of this government-sponsored relief and development project.

May 24, 1844: Telegraph inventor Samuel Morse, sent the first official telegraph message, "What hath God wrought?" from the Capitol building in Washington, D.C., to Baltimore.

May 31, 1977: The final weld was completed on the Trans-Alaska Pipeline.

Wow! These past two months have been a whirlwind and at this reading, Robin and I are in Anchorage settling into our new home.

There are so many things I would like to say as we begin this new chapter of ministry. I am overwhelmed with the grace God has shown us and cannot express in words how blessed we are to return home and join Alaska Baptists and other Great Commission believers in reaching our state for Christ. However, let me be expedient and share what God has laid on my heart by focusing on three words: *love, respect, and cooperation.*

- <u>LOVE</u>. I am so thankful to be a recipient of God's unconditional love! He pursued me even when I turned away from Him and He never gave up on me. When I disappoint Him in my daily life, His love is unchanging. His Word challenges us to love each other the same way He loves us. That's a hard thing to do. I pray that we, as Alaska Baptists, will be characterized by an unconditional and unchanging love that draws us closer to God and one another. That kind of love is contagious and will attract those who don't yet know the love of a Heavenly Father.
- <u>RESPECT</u>. At different times in my ministry, it has been my experience that fellow servants may be suspicious and even critical of one other. However, I am convinced that God has called His saints to serve Him in the unique ways He has gifted them and in the unique settings He has placed them. Let us rejoice, encourage and build each other up in the work of the Lord. My prayer is that we will be known as encouragers and supporters of those who serve to advance the Kingdom of our God.
- <u>COOPERATION</u>. I learned from childhood that Southern Baptists were known for their cooperative spirit. As a young seminary student, I studied all the ways Southern Baptist churches cooperate together to reach a lost world for Christ. I was amazed to learn how the Cooperative Program supported work across America and around the world. It made me proud to be called a Southern Baptist. We can do so much more together than we can laboring alone in our own settings. I pray that we can rediscover the spirit of cooperation that identified us in America for so many decades of ministry. I covenant with you to love and respect each other and to Christ.

Waiting in the Salt Lake City airport recently, I enjoyed "people watching" - seeing people of all shapes and sizes and colors, with some very interesting clothing! In late March, while hosting David Burton during the statewide Personal Evangelism Training sessions, I became fascinated watching David share Jesus with practically everyone he met. There were times I had to drag David out of a store or restaurant in order to get to our destination on time. During David's visit, God touched my heart about opening my mouth and simply sharing Jesus with others. As David mentioned, we don't have time to relate to someone all the time; we may get only one opportunity to introduce a person to Christ. We can be relational and never share the gospel! We may have just two or three minutes to lift the name of Jesus and I was totally convicted to be more evangelistic. The longer I have lived in Alaska, the more inward I have become, and have justified my lack of sharing Jesus with serving Jesus in busy tasks. Even worse, I have bought into the lie the Deceiver wants me to believe and that is, I must relate with others to earn the right to share Jesus. David shared the gospel with about 50 strangers and no one was turned off! Two didn't show an interest but the rest were grateful. I was really amazed with the wild-eyed, bearded and tattooed server at a local restaurant; after showing him a little love in Jesus' name, he really warmed up. How will he respond to the next person who asks if he has ever heard about Jesus? God will use this one touch that was engaging and not offensive, to draw him one step closer to Him. As David would say, "keep bragging on Jesus." The more we brag, the more they will hear; the more they hear, the more the Holy Spirit will use His Word, our witness, our love and our boldness to be salt and light. Think about how that works with those we see all the time; have you seen the same bank teller, gas station attendant or waitperson over and over again for months and have never told them the greatest thing that ever happened to you? Be bold – be doubly bold - to share Christ. Just ask someone, "Has anyone told you today that Jesus loves you?" If that is not your "style", then how will you do it? I want to hear about successful ways you are sharing Jesus. During Personal Evangelism Training, David worked with me to train 105 people from 21 churches. Envision those 105 people, from Fairbanks to Anchorage to Juneau, sharing their faith daily. Imagine the difference it would make! I would like to see 75 churches conduct Personal Evangelism Training and train 500 people to share their faith on a daily basis.
