

## Mary's Song of Praise

an there be a better story in the annals of literary history that compares with the birth of Christ? No one but God could conceive such a compelling story of love and

commitment. I am always enamored with a young lady by the name of Mary who had yet to reach full maturity, but was thrown into the position of accepting the unique plan of God for her life. While our focus should always be on the Savior who came as a gift from the Father in heaven, there is much to learn from the life of a willing and obedient servant like Mary.

Mary's song of praise, recorded in Luke 1:46-55, portrays a childlike faith in God that was most likely learned as a little girl in the synagogue. Since teaching was an oral tradition and memorization the final test, she must have committed most of the psalms to memory. It is no wonder the song that poured from her heart and lips encapsulates the full character of God learned through the singing of psalms.

Praise becomes the natural expression of love and thanksgiving, voicing the joy we experience deep in our souls. I am always moved when I read the lyrics of her song of praise.

... because the Mighty One has done great things for me, and His name is Holy. (v 49)

Perhaps Mary learned the truth about His **Holiness** from singing Psalm 99.

## *His mercy is from generation to generation on those who fear Him.* (*v 50*)

Psalm 118 is a pleasant reminder that His **Mercy** endures forever.

#### He has done a mighty deed with His arm...

*He has toppled the mighty from their thrones.* (*v 51-52*) His **Power** to display His mighty works would be demonstrated once again through her conception and delivery of a Messiah and it evoked a song of praise such as found in Psalm 66.

#### He has satisfied the hungry with good things... He has helped His servant Israel... (v 53-55)

Mary needed to know that God was a **Compassionate** God and Psalm 116 allowed her to reflect on His promise to deliver those who trust in Him.

What is your song of praise? During this Christmas season, my prayer for each of you is that, like Mary, you will be reminded of God's holiness and mercy as well as His power and compassion, and His sincere desire to bless you and provide for you an abundant life.

- 1. Approved the new committee structure of the ABC Executive Board. Copy is in master file.
- 2. Approved the May 8-9, 2017, ABC Executive Board Meeting Minutes. Copy is in master file.
- 3. Approved the Sept. 26-27, 2017, ABC Annual Meeting Minutes. Copy is in master file.
- 4. Approved the October 2017 Financial Reports. Copy is in master file.
- 5. Approved creating four designated accounts, one account for each NAMB funding bucket. The designated accounts are to be named: Existing Church Evangelism Strategies, Church Plant Evangelism Strategies, Church Planting Development Funds, and Church Planting Funds using the next available account numbers. Also approved updating the chart of accounts with the NAMB description on how these funds are to be used. Copy of NAMB's description on how these funds are to be used is in the master file.

- 7. Approved to invite Cheryl Dowd to assess the Alaska Baptist Convention's 2017 financial records in 2018.
- 8. Approved to change the 73rd annual meeting place from Muldoon Road Baptist Church to First Baptist Church, Wasilla; and change the 75th annual meeting place from First Baptist Church, Wasilla to First Baptist Church, Anchorage.
- 9. Approved Jae McKee as our recommended candidate to serve as the ABC's full time State Director of Church Planting and Missions, employed by NAMB.
- 10. Approved to clarify the meaning of ABC Bylaws Article VI, Section 2—that the Executive Board authorize the Executive Committee to act on its behalf with full authority when the Executive Board is not in regular session.

The purpose of the task force is to investigate how local churches may minister to the homeless population. Their first report will be presented at the May 2018 Executive Board meeting and the final report presented at the November 2018 Executive Board meeting.
- 16. Approved to elect Barbara Sandberg, member of Glacier Valley Baptist Church, Juneau, to replace Brea Mearig on the Birchwood Behavioral Health Board of Directors with term expiring 2020.
- 17. Approved to elect Ted Sutton, pastor of First Native Baptist Church, Anchorage, to replace George Stewart on the Birchwood Behavioral Health Board of Directors with term expiring 2019.
- 18. Approved the 2018 housing allowances submitted by Randy Covington, Jimmy Stewart, and Jae McKee. A copy of each housing allowance request can be found in their personnel file.
