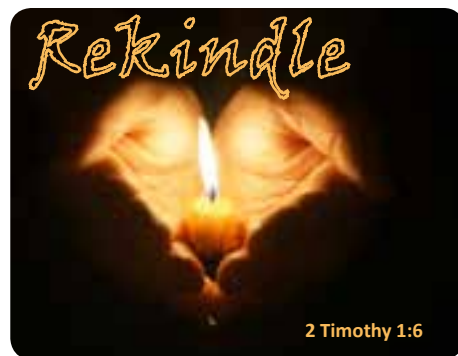

Rekindle



It was a cold morning at the homestead as I woke up before anyone else in the house. It was not by choice! It was my turn to stoke the woodstove and get the fire roaring so it would be warm when the rest of the family got up. As I shuffled through the house shivering with a blanket draped around me, I hoped the fire had not totally gone out. If it had, I would have to gather some kindling and paper and start a new fire. Fortunately, there were some bright embers left that only required that I fan the coals and bring them back to life.

Paul encouraged Timothy in his second letter with these words: “Therefore, I remind you to **rekindle the gift of God that is in you** through the laying on of my hands.” (2 Timothy 1:6 CSB) The New Living Translation uses the phrase “fan into flames the spiritual gift God gave you.” When I read this passage, I can’t help but go back to those homestead days and think about those embers. There are several things that I have learned through the years as I have contemplated the truth of these words.

First of all, God is the one who builds the fire within us. Through the Holy Spirit, He has gifted us to offer our lives in service to Him and others. Even though Paul was instrumental in encouraging the gift by laying his hands on Timothy, it was God’s flame. The flame burns brightly when it is fed and stoked consistently and offers its greatest value when it burns at full force.

So often the flame begins to subside as we get distracted by circumstances of life and the frustration we feel living in a fallen world that runs from the warmth of God’s love. Eventually the flame diminishes to nothing more than warm embers that are in danger of being extinguished. While

God stands ready to renew us and rekindle that fire, it is our responsibility to fan it into flame.

Sometimes we need the help of others to rekindle that fire. While God is the only one who can keep the fire burning within us, he often uses His servants to stand with us and walk us through the process of revitalization. It may only take some encouragement to rekindle the embers that remain and at times it may require more attention to rebuild what was once a vibrant and brilliant fire.

The theme of our annual meeting this year is **REKINDLE** and our theme verse is 2 Timothy 1:6. I know we all need this rekindling in our personal lives and I am convinced that many of our churches are also in grave need of revitalization. Join us this year at College Heights Baptist Church in Soldotna for the 74th annual meeting of the Alaska Baptist Convention September 24-25 as we commit ourselves anew to burn brightly for the cause of Christ in Alaska.

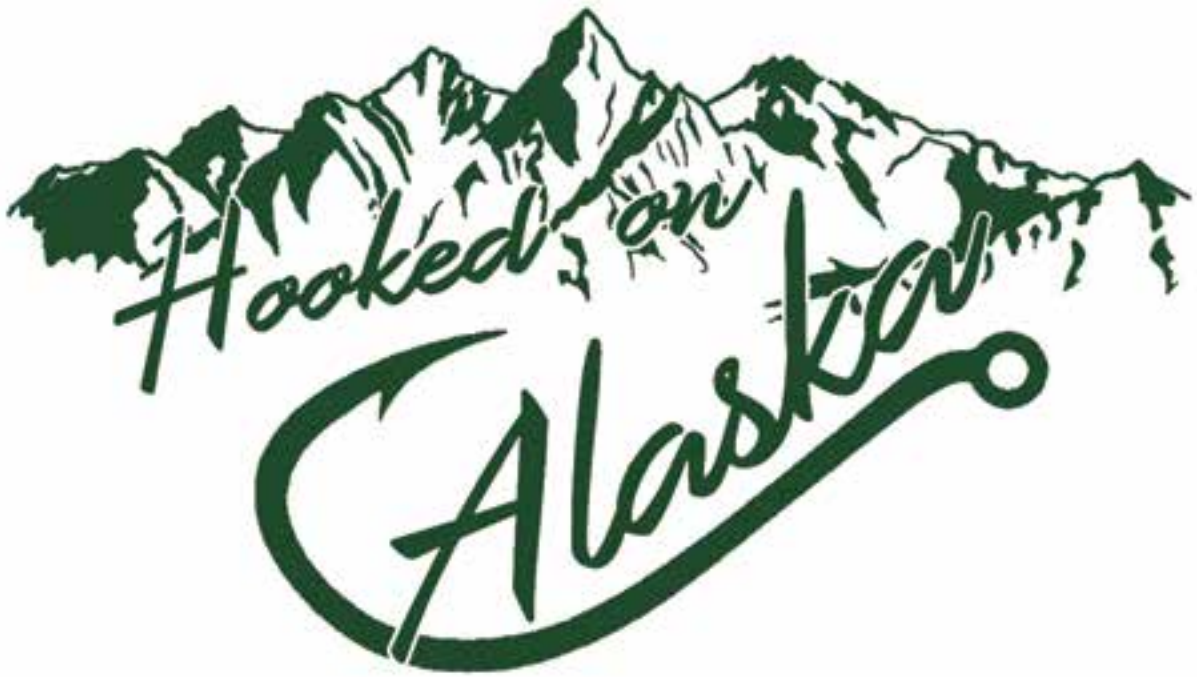

Alaska Baptist Convention (ABC) Executive Board Actions

May 6-7, 2019

submitted by Debra Long, Operation and Finance Administrator, ABC

1. Approved November 12-13, 2018, ABC Executive Board Meeting minutes as read.
2. Approved giving the Executive Director authority to purchase a new phone system for the ABC with a price not to exceed \$15,000 and keeping in mind quality and durability.
3. Approved the following changes to the Policies and Procedures (P&P) Manual:
 - a. Changing the wording of P&P Manual II, Article I, Part-Time Employee, the first sentence to read, "Routinely works less than 32 hours per week."
 - b. Changing P&P Manual II, Article IV Holidays, Section 1 to read, "Holidays Falling on Friday, Saturday, or Sunday. If a holiday falls on a Friday, Saturday, or Sunday, the following Monday is considered a holiday."
 - c. Deleting P&P Manual III, Article XI Other Restricted Use Funds, Section C, Item 6. Account 5746 is no longer an active account in the ABC budget.
 - d. Changing P&P Manual III, Article XX. Christmas Love Gift last sentence to read, "For hourly workers, one percent (1%) is based on the annual total amount of income and prorated if less than one year of service, but no less than \$100.00."
4. Approved to amend the minutes of the November 2018 board meeting to reflect an excused absence by Cliff Day for knee surgery.
5. Approved the March 2019 Financial Reports.
6. Approved to inactivate accounts 5520 Sunday School, 5530 Discipleship Training, 5536 Church Music, and 5544 Support Programs and create account 5560 Church Resources. This broader term will assist in utilizing LifeWay's funds to its fullest potential, and to change the Chart of Accounts to remove the above-mention inactivated accounts

and add the following description to account 5560 Church Resources: This account is to provide churches with training for Sunday School, small groups, discipleship training, music and worship training, pay for the Alaska Baptist Convention's annual CCLI License, and for materials and assistance with support programs that help ABC churches in the area of church development.

7. Approved the 2020 ABC Proposed Budget. This proposed budget represents a \$16,702.58 increase of anticipated Cooperative Program offerings over last year's budget.
8. Approved to grant \$10,000 from Account 8196 State Missions State-Wide for remote mission travel throughout the year depending on need.
9. Approved to assist supporting Mosaic Campus Ministries with travel and operation expenses throughout the State of Alaska by granting a one-time payment of \$7,500 from Account 8196 State-Wide Missions for 2019, with future recurring funds of \$15,000 of the ABC budgeting process beginning with the 2020 ABC Proposed Budget.
10. Approved to set the date of the 78th Annual Meeting to be September 26-27, 2023. The times will be set by the Order of Business Committee when planning the meeting.
11. Approved to adopt the theme "Rekindle" for the 2019 Annual Meeting based on 2 Timothy 1:6 "Therefore, I remind you to rekindle the gift of God that is in you through the laying on of my hands." The dedication page of the Book of Reports will honor the lives of former pastors Rodney Kovtynovich, Gene Medaris, and Roy Moore who passed away this past year.
