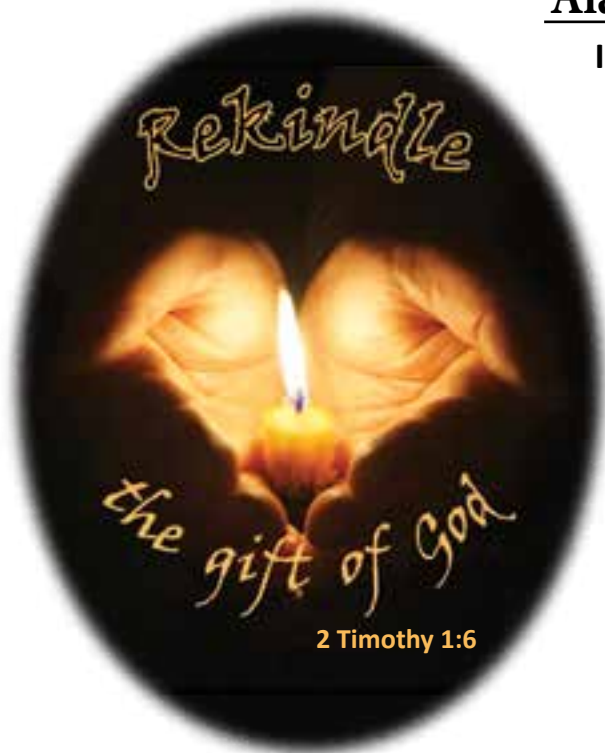

It's August...

August in Alaska is almost always a treat! August salmon and trout fishing is usually great in the many rivers and streams of our great state and the shortening daylight and cooler temperatures begin to usher in hunting seasons that some have looked forward to all year. The last of summer camping and berry picking trips with school age kids are fun and exciting as they look forward, some with dread, to rejoining their schoolmates and friends back in the classroom and on the playground.

For Alaska Baptists, August is a time of preparation for fall, recovery from the craziness of summer activities and an opportunity to enjoy the remaining days before the long darkness and snows of winter.

August is also the month leading up to our **Valeria Sherard State Mission Offering Emphasis** in September. **September 1-8, 2019**, is our VSSMO Week of Prayer for State Missions. Our **goal** this year for the State Mission Offering is **\$90,000**. Each year we receive requests in excess of mission funds available and are consistently discovering needs that we would like to meet. We as a state have not met or exceeded our offering goal in several years. I am prayerful that this year will be the year of exception. I challenge each of us to give generously this year to rise up and meet the needs of our fellow Alaska Baptists as we all seek to Discover, Develop and Deploy those whom God has placed around us for His Kingdom expansion and **exceed** the \$90,000 goal for State Missions.

The Power of a Praying Church

E.M. Bounds in his little book *“Power Through Prayer”* says, *“The Church is looking for better methods; God is looking for better men. What the Church needs today is not more machinery or better, not new organizations or more and novel methods, but men whom the Holy Ghost can use -- men of prayer, men mighty in prayer.”*

One of the common frustrations of many pastors is the inability to initiate and maintain a powerful prayer ministry. It’s certainly been true for me. Thankfully, God has been helping us to change that at The Crossing. It hasn’t always been *easy*, but it’s always been *good*.

My prayer is that, as I share what our Prayer Ministry currently looks like, God will use this to strengthen your own lives and ministries.

Corporate Prayer

1) We offer a ‘prayer altar’ time after the invitation at every service. Dozens of people typically come forward. Most kneel and pray on their own, while a few approach prayer team members to ask for prayer.

2) Monday Morning- 7 a.m.- We pray together for 50 minutes. Coffee and a light breakfast is provided after.

3) Sunday Night 5:30-7:00 p.m.- A short, intimate time of worship and an opportunity for personal prayer is followed by intensive, directed prayer. Every staff member and family is prayed for by name, including praying over marriages, ministries and specific needs. Missionaries, local missions, and short-term mission teams are prayed for by name. Other directed prayer is based upon current ministry needs.

Staff Prayer Team

Requests are gathered from the congregation each Sunday during the offering. A box that says ‘Confidential’ may be checked. Staff prays for all requests on Monday morning.

Those marked ‘Confidential’ are seen only by the Staff Prayer Team. All others are posted on our ‘Prayer Chain.’

Congregational Prayer Chain

Any adult who desires can be added to the Prayer Chain. Requests that come in Sunday morning are posted on Monday, and other requests are posted as they come to us. In this way we can have 330 families praying over requests in a very short period of time.

Senior Center Prayer Warriors

We provide a written copy of prayer requests to about 30 individuals at the Chugiak Senior Center, and have enlisted them in the ministry of prayer.

P3- (Pastor’s Prayer Partners)

1) This group of men and women (currently 38) makes a year-long commitment to arrive early every Sunday morning to pray for the pastor. They pray together in a room provided for that purpose. Five minutes before the service begins, they come into the sanctuary, lay hands on the preaching pastor and pray for the anointing of the Holy Spirit upon the pastor and the message.

2) The pastor sends personal prayer requests to this group that he does not share with the whole church family. This group has assumed the responsibility of caring for the pastor, his family and the ministry through prayer.
