# 2025 - A Year of Opportunity Randy Covington, Executive Director

2025 – Another year – another opportunity. As we step into a new year with the perpetual opportunities that face us, my mind races back over the past 50 years of ministry. Yes, I can't believe it has been 50 years of serving the Lord through the local church and on the mission field. There have been so many blessings that have accompanied that journey and so many people that have been instrumental in mentoring, challenging, and assisting us in the divine call. But there have also been many missed opportunities that we have let slip by.

Paul expressed himself to the elders of the Ephesian church by stating. "... my purpose is to finish my course and the ministry I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify to the gospel of God's grace." (Acts 20:24 CSB) His grace has been so abundant in my life, and I have sought to always represent Him well in every aspect of my ministry. We are now approaching the final year of ministry here in Alaska and I don't want to miss another opportunity to fulfill my calling and know His pleasure in my life and service. This compels me to share some lessons learned along the way that I pray will be encouraging to you.

- 1. A Call to Obedience When I first knew that God was calling me to full-time ministry, I assumed He was calling me to music ministry. In most of the churches I served, that included youth ministry. It was a combination position spurred by a lack of funding for two ministers. When the call came to leave Alaska and go overseas, I described it as a call to missions. There came a moment when God revealed to me that my call was not to missions, but to obedience. It was not to a particular place, task or title, but a call to obey Him wherever it might lead.
- 2. A Commitment to the Long Haul After two years of preparation to move overseas, I was anxious to get busy with sharing the gospel in a cross-cultural setting. I pushed myself to fill my days with ministry which caused me to neglect my family and to burn all the energy reserves I could muster each day. After four and a half years, I was facing burnout. A mentor in my life explained to me that I must decide: should I shine bright for as long as I can and then quickly burn out, or should I pace myself for the long haul? That reminded me of my high school running coach who said that long distance running required setting a steady pace that allowed for storing up energy for the final lap.
- 3. A Compulsion to Love God More Each Day Once I found my stride in ministry, it became comfortable to fall into a daily routine that was more focused on performance than on relationship. While discipling new believers to spend time in the Word and in prayer, building a relationship with the Father in Heaven, I was not practicing what I was teaching. I thought what I was doing for God was sufficient in strengthening my own faith. But it was not strengthening my relationship with God. This is a continuous struggle for me as I can easily fill my day with things to do and fail to spend quality time with my Lord and Savior.
- 4. A Challenge to Work in Harmony with Others My musical background in choral conducting compelled me to work with musicians to bring perfect harmony to whatever piece of music we were preparing to perform. That same challenge has spilled over into my service for the Kingdom of God. I have learned that other Kingdom workers bring diverse talents and abilities to the task of the Great Commission that I don't have. Our call to obedience requires that we work in harmony with each other to fulfill that commission. Jesus prayed, "May they all be one as you, Father, are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us, so that the world may believe you sent me." (John 17:21 CSB)

5. A Constant Focus on the Mission – Since I grew up in a Christian home, I was very familiar with the usual routines of church attendance. Even in my first ministry assignment in the church, I was focused on doing the traditional things that all churches do. I soon came to understand that all those activities should ultimately lead to the proclamation of the gospel message. That is the mission of the church! The mission should always be the driving force in everything we do. I have learned not to ask the question of what is best for the organization I serve, but to ask what is best for the accomplishment of the mission to which God has called me.

There will be many opportunities for Alaska Baptists in 2025. My prayer is that we will be obedient to His call and focus on what is best for the long haul of ministry in Alaska. May God's grace and compassion compel us to seek Him more intimately and know Him more fully in that love relationship. May we find unity and harmony that will ultimately propel us to find our perfect stride in the fulfillment of our mandate, our mission, and our motivation for honoring God and bringing Him the glory He alone deserves. When your church chooses to send a portion of it's tithes and offerings through the Cooperative Program, it immediately begins making a difference both here at home in Alaska and around the world. Alaska Baptist joyfully link arms with 41 other state conventions in supporting the following SBC entities:

- More than 4,600 missionaries serving in other nations through the International Mission Board.
- More than 2,200 North American Mission Board missionaries serving across the U.S. and Canada.
- More than 14,000 students are being equipped and educated by SBC owned seminaries.
- The Ethics and Religious Liberties Commission, which addresses social and moral issues.

Even as 42 state conventions, including our own, support these SBC entities, Alaska Baptists provide support for the following Great Commission Ministries with the portion of Cooperative Program gifts that remain in the state:

- Alaska Baptist Resource Network (Alaska Baptist Convention), which helps local churches and association in such
  efforts as evangelizing the lost, discipling believers, planting churches, responding to disasters, mobilizing for
  missions, sharing Christ on college campuses, developing church leaders and assisting to coordinate partnership
  between local churches, associations and other state conventions.
- Camps such a Camp Baldiwin and LaVerne Griffin Camp which minister to and share the gospel with families, youth and children annually as well as provide space for churches to host retreats and activities throughout the year.
- Faith Recovery Fellowship, a ministry in the Mat-Su valley that maintain a presence for evangelism and discipleship in the prison systems and a recovery/re-entry home for those attempting to come back into the workforce and society following incarceration.
- Mosaic Campus ministry which supports and provides a gospel presence on the campuses of University of Alaska Anchorage, University of Alaska Fairbanks and University of Alaska Southeast in Juneau.

Coupled with our Valeria Sherard State Missions Offering and the 2000 Club quarterly calls, Alaska Baptist have a robust system for sharing the gospel of Christ within our state, nation and around the world!

What better way to live out our faith and meet the challenges of the New Year 2025 than with a renewed commitment to participate in and be a champion for OUR Cooperative Program of the Southern Baptist Convention as we celebrate the 100th Anniversary of cooperative missions together!

#### Six Practices of Disciple-Making

Disciple-making is not a program; it's a fleestyle. This is a big truth. Leus said, "Follow Me and I will make you fishers of men" (Matt 4:19). Clearly, this was no call to join a disciple-inhip program but an invitation to a lifestyle of disciple-making. According to Jesus, this lifestyle is the supreme purpose of every believer. You cannot be a true follower of Jesus without becoming a failure of the without becoming a subject of the without becoming a subject of the without becoming a subject of the without becoming a su

Common Misconceptions There are some common misconceptions in today's church about disciple-making. Som hink? it is merely evangelism. Certainly evangelism is a vital part of disciple-making but making converts is not the same as makin disciples. You can do evangelism without bein a disciple maker, but you cannot be a disciple maker without doing evangelism.

Others think disciple-making is merely doin. Bible study, Again, Bible study is a whal part or disciple-making, but there is a problem. Man participate in great Bible studies and them wan to know when its next one and the next on and the next one. True disciple-making is no Bible study alone. We often find ourselve making great Bible learners but no reproducing disciple makers.

Christ's Model

With no buildings or budgets, Jesus launched a disciple-making movement that exploded upon the world. In comparison, the church today has discipleship programs, but few disciple-making people. We must exchange our misconcepts about discipleship for Christ's model of disciple-

dight make any other kind. Apart from dight make any other kind. Apart from multiplication, there is no real discipleship. Multiplication is the key to reaching our world for Christ. However, most churches today lack a simple process for equipipine believers to make and to multiply disciples. For the most part, we are attempting to reach the world by addition, and we simply cannot keep pace and we simply cannot keep pace.
